## Summer Camp Q & A

### Q: What will campers do during camp?

A: Campers will experience hands-on science through classroom activities, demonstrations, experiments and floor exploration.

### Q: What is the child to adult ratio?

A: Ages 3-5 have a ratio of 6 children to 1 adult at camp. Ages 5-8 and 8-11 camps have a ratio of 8 children to 1 adult. Introduction to LEGO Robotics, Advanced LEGO Robotics and ages 10-13 camps have a ratio of 9 children to 1 adult.

### Q: What are drop off and pick up policies?

A: Science Central requires that an adult drops off and picks up each camper. Authorized adults, as specified on the camp registration form, will sign campers in and out of camp programs each day.

### Q: Will campers leave the building?

A: We may go outside for certain activities, including visits to Lawton Park.

### Q: When and what do campers eat?

A: Science Central provides one snack in the morning and afternoon. Campers must bring their own lunch to Summer Camp.

### Q: What is Science Central's refund policy?

A: Full refunds are available two weeks prior to camp. After this date, no refunds will be issued unless a physician's note can verify absence.
