

Camper Behavior Contract For _____

Parents/Guardians and campers should review the camp behavior contract so we can work towards creating a fun and safe camp experience for everyone.

Camp Behavior Expectations:

1. Treat everyone with kindness and respect.
2. Respect the property of Science Central and others.
3. Respect other's feelings and differences.
4. Be willing to try.
5. Use appropriate language, what may be appropriate for you at home might not be for others.
6. Ask for help from a camp staff when you have a problem or see others having an issue.
7. Be responsible for your own belongings, even if we go outside.
8. Always stay with your group.
9. Be the boss of your own body. Nobody gets to make your body feel unsafe and you don't get to make anyone else feel unsafe.
10. Have fun.

The following behaviors are not allowed:

1. Fighting, rough housing, or engaging in unsafe behavior.
2. Threatening or bullying anyone or joining in when others are bullying.
3. Sharing or trading food. We sometimes have campers with severe food allergies.
4. Taking things that don't belong to you.
5. Being disrespectful to staff or other campers. This includes "trash talking" or being intentionally mean.
6. Bringing electronics or toys from home.
7. Bringing any weapons, drugs, or alcohol to camp.

Failure to follow these expectations or doing any of the behaviors not allowed will follow a three-strike system.

1. Camp staff will issue a warning to you.
2. Camp Director will discuss behavior with you and offer choices to change said behavior.
3. Camp Director will bring you up to their office and call your parent/guardian to explain what behaviors were happening.

The parent/guardian and Director must agree the camper should not be in the class for the day or week. In the situation where they disagree, the Camp Director and Director of Education will make the final decision.

NOTE: If camper is sent home due to continued behavior, a refund will NOT be issued.
